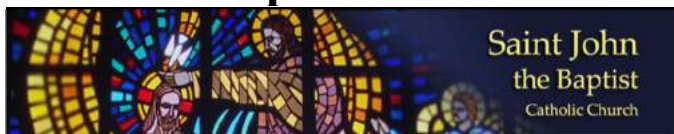

The feast of the Epiphany, which we celebrate so soon after Christmas, represents the revealing of the Savior's birth to the Gentile nations.
