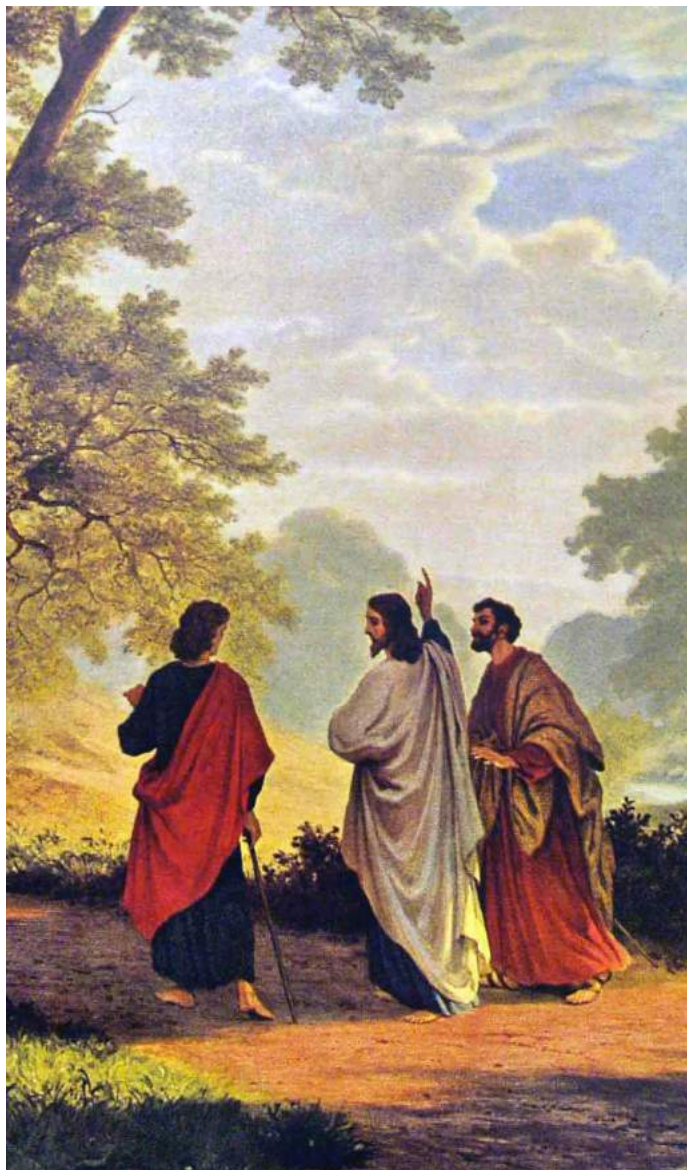

Our contemporary society offers us great improvements in lifestyle be it in foods, housing, healthcare, transportation, education, arts or sciences. As advanced as we have become in some experiences, we may be regressing in other areas such as quality of life, care of the aged, family stability and worldwide hunger. One additional area of concern involves young people.

How in an affluent society do we "teach" children to appreciate important things in life? It appears that very many of our children have all their material needs more than satisfied. They not only take it for granted - they more or less expect it. This situation immunizes them from appreciating simple things. As adults, our responsibility extends to making young people aware of how to appreciate all things in life.

Our youngest parishioners will receive the Holy Eucharist for the first time next week. In simplicity, they are awed by this privilege of being permitted to receive their Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ into their bodies. For the first time, they unite as human beings with God in this sacramental experience. May they always cherish this great gift.

On this occasion we may ask ourselves, do we appreciate fully the great gift of the Eucharist which is available to us daily? Does routine cause us to reduce the awe we should have in a personal encounter with God? Do we benefit from this sacramental experience as effectively, engaging each time in its privilege?

May First Holy Communion in our parish provoke each of us to pose this question: Do I sufficiently appreciate my reception of the Holy Eucharist, a moment of transformation to receive who and what I want to become?
