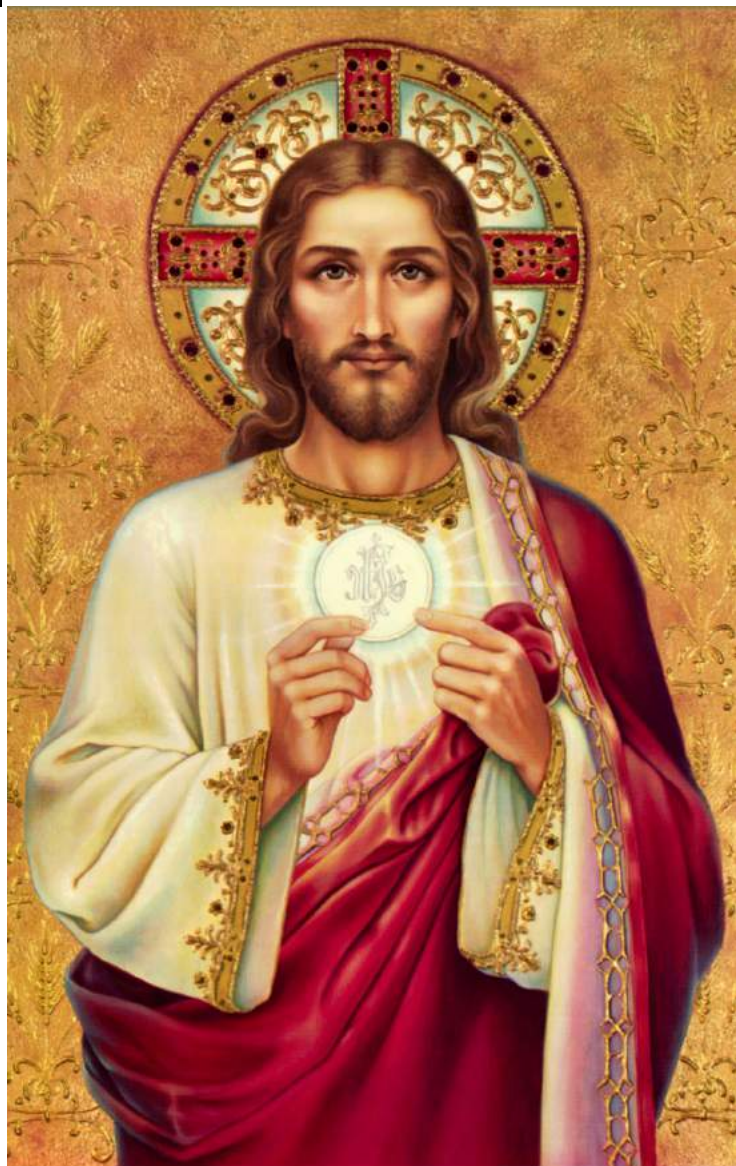

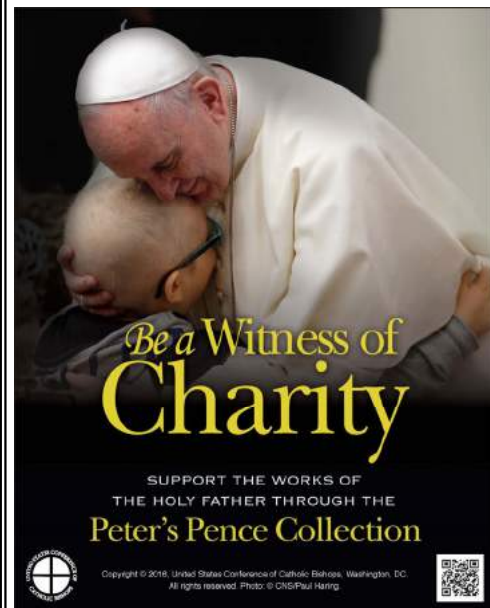
Our Novena and Benediction Service and Rosary:
