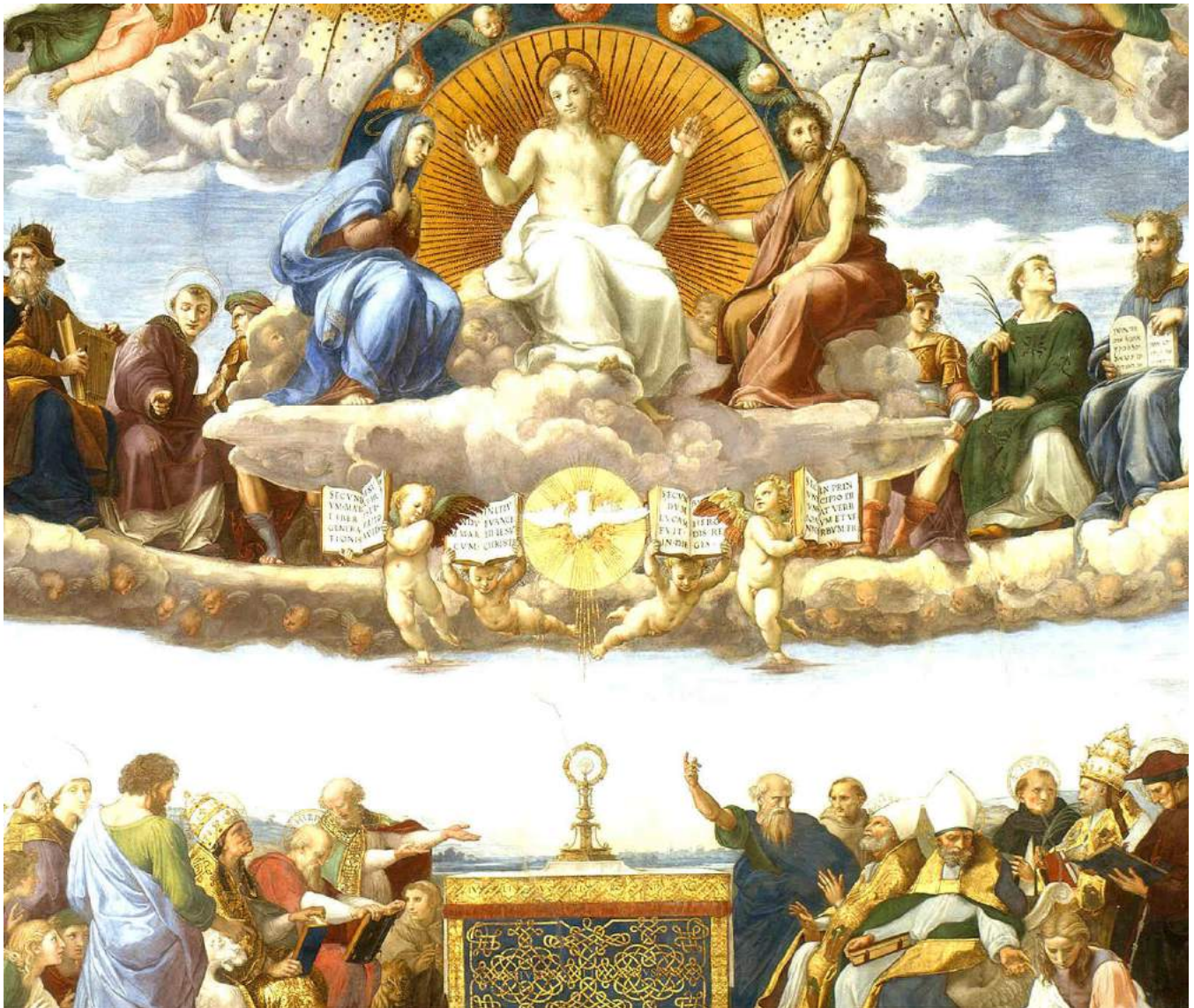

On this Corpus Christi Sunday (Body of Christ) may we rekindle an appreciation of the great gift of Christ’s presence among us!

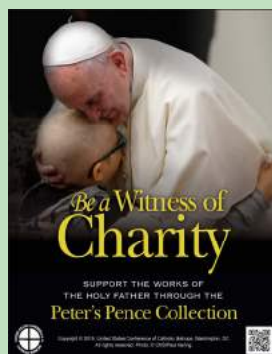
