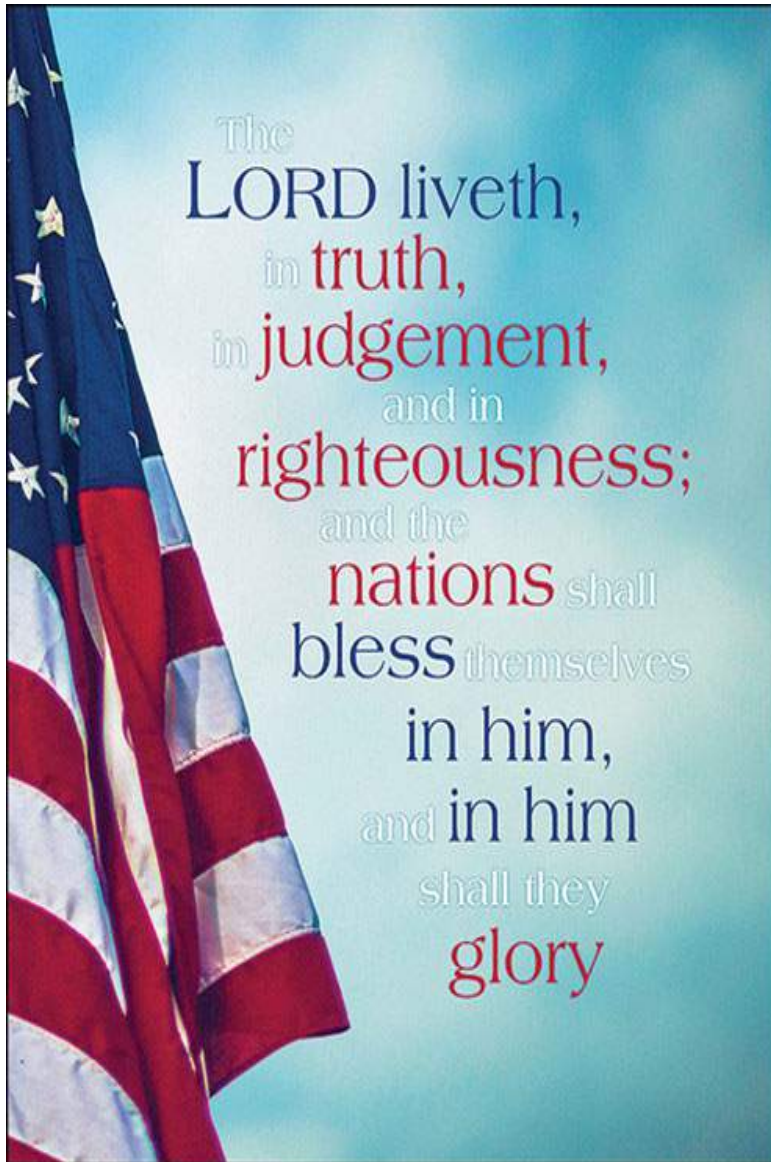

**“One Nation Under God”**

Our country was built by visionaries: idealists maybe, but yet they were pragmatic. Realistically, the pressure is increasing to remain competitive and the problems may increase. Unless . . .

If we are to carry on the vision of freedom in our land as initiated by our founders, we must show concern for those who need to be brought into the mainstream, particularly from a Christian viewpoint. We need to respond to those from within, and without, who might impede our achieving our stated goals and assisting those who fall through the cracks. Their numbers are increasing daily. May we be visionaries and attempt to take our society the next step where peace and justice for all will be the norm. May God always be a part of this effort founded centuries ago and continuing today.
