Next weekend I encourage you to participate in the annual Black and Indian Mission Collection. This collection has for the last 135 years, changed the landscape of evangelization and education efforts for Native Americans, Alaskan Americans and African Americans throughout the United States. 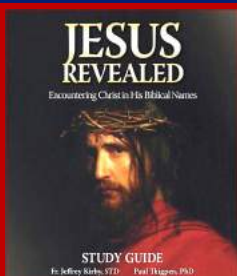
