Homebound: Please contact the Rectory to register for home visits for those unable to attend Mass.

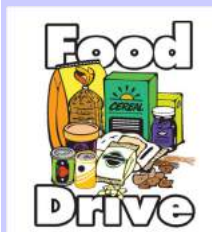
Women's Guild: Monthly meetings are held Oct - May, 2nd Wed. at 9:30am. Boutique workshops are Wed. at 9:30am

We pray for the joyful repose of the soul of our beloved priest, Father James F. Daly, who went home to the Lord last Sunday, July 7, 2019.

Father Daly was born in Frances Street, Kilrush, Co. Clare to Jane (née O’Shea) and Thomas Daly on 14th December 1936. He entered Kilshane, a Spiritan novitiate in 1955, and then continued his education at Kimmage Manor. He completed his studies in Philosophy in 1958 and Theology in 1964. He was

awarded a BA from University College of Dublin and prefectured for one year in Blackrock College.

Father Jim was ordained in 1963, and his first appointment was to Sierra Leone. He served in Sierra Leone for seven years in a combination of roles of pastoral and educational ministry. He always fondly recalled his missionary work there and the strong influence it had on the rest of his life.

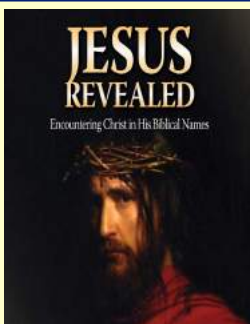
He moved to the United States in the early 1970s, fundraising for the Sierra Leone diocese in New York City, where he was a very welcoming host. He was awarded an M.A. in Education by St. John’s University, Brooklyn in 1979 and became Provincial Delegate that same year, conducting mission appeals for the Irish Province of the Spiritans.

Father Daly began serving as an associate pastor at St. John’s in 1989, serving our community for almost thirty years before returning to Kimmage in 2016. He baptized many of our children, married many of our young couples, and helped us send many of our loved ones home to the Lord. He joined us for lunch and dinner, adding a joke at every occasion. He will be remembered for the laughter and the love that he brought us over the years. He will be missed by all who knew him.

We offer our prayerful sympathies to his family, relatives, Spiritan confrères and friends.

Eternal rest grant to Father Jim, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon him. May the soul of our friend, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. I believe Father Daly would like us to remember him this way:

*I'd like the memory of me to be a happy one.
I'd like to leave an afterglow of smiles when life is done.
I'd like to leave an echo whispering softly down the ways,
Of happy times and laughing times and bright and sunny days.
I'd like the tears of those who grieve, to dry before the sun;
Of happy memories that I leave when life is done.*
