“Our Father”

Classical music is often characterized by its longevity - it appears to have been around forever. To some old-timers classical means the three B's: Brahms, Beethoven and Bach. A prayer which falls into the classical category for Christians is The Lord's Prayer, the Our Father. It has passed the test of time and it is part of our daily lives. But like so many habits and familiar prayers, we sometimes say the words with our lips only. Prayers should find their roots in the heart.

The very first word of this prayer speaks to us of our worldwide community. The word “our” takes in all of us. There is no room for excluding anyone. When we pray “Our Father,” we include everyone, even those who differ from us or have quarreled with us.

“Hallowed be your name” has often been distorted into “Hollowed be your name” as if we were hollowing out a pumpkin for Halloween. Hallowed means “holy” or “respected.” May God, the Father's name, always be held in deep reverence and respect. What a sad reminder that many people use the name of God disrespectfully.

“Your will be done” is a pattern of life. This is the part of the prayer that is quite difficult as we come face-to-face with difficulties we are sure to encounter. Even Jesus himself prayed these words on the night he suffered agony in the Garden of Gethsemane. But each of us knows that doing God's will is the path to true peace and it will lead to eternal glory with the Lord forever.

Daily bread and the grace to forgive others are our constant needs and so we seek these blessings from the God who is Our Father. When our mind wanders or we become anxious during the day, we can always bring up from our treasure of “classical” memories this wonderful prayer taught to us by the Lord himself. It can bring us closer to God and help to bring us peace.

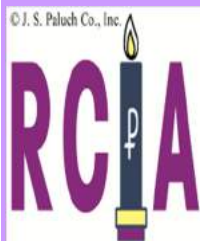
