God, through the Transfiguration, You showed Jesus in glory, a glimpse of what would be seen in His risen life. Bless us with an awareness of Your presence, leading us to share Your love even in daily struggles. Help us to deepen our knowledge of the Law and the Prophets, channels of Your grace throughout history, and guides for our journey. Amen.

“Slow Down, You’re Going Too Fast”

The pace of life appears to be intensifying for all of us. With increased travel capacity, instant communication available to us, competitive work demands, consuming multitasking, expanding family obligations and considerate volunteering, it is difficult to have a moment to ourselves.

Do we really need such moments of quiet to reenergize, reflect, and renew? We can suggest that everybody else needs such time but it is difficult to focus on our own need. Hyperactivity may be the control of our lives and could be a concern.

Today’s Gospel shows clearly that Peter was a man of action: he always needed to be doing something. So on Mount Tabor, instead of contemplating in silence and wonder the glory of his Lord, he wanted to build three tents. There is though a time for stillness, for contemplation, for wonder, for adoration in the presence of God. A time to heed the words of the psalmist: ‘Be still and know that I am God.’ Sometimes we are too busy. We would be better to be silent, to be listening, to be wondering, to be adoring in the presence of God.

Is it possible for us to set aside time in which we do nothing? Really, it should be considered as unscheduled time away from the conventional demands. What do we do, what do we think about, how do we while away the hours!

If a conversation with another is one-sided, it becomes more a lecture than a dialog. With the Lord, we talk to Him in praise or request. Does He ever get a word in? Moments of quiet in church, at home, with nature, give us opportunity to think or not think, to hear or not hear, to clear the mind of distractions. Slow down! Experience the quiet.

- Are you a Catholic who desires to complete the initiation process by receiving the Eucharist and Confirmation?

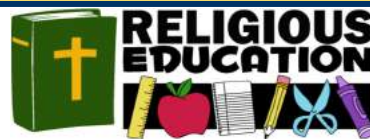
