

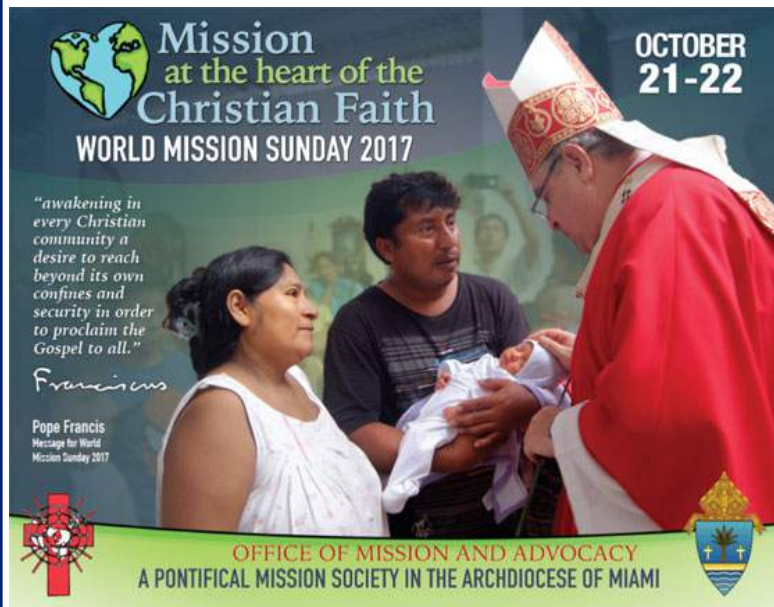


CURIOUS ABOUT THE CATHOLIC FAITH?
