Oh, God bless you and keep you, Mother Machree.

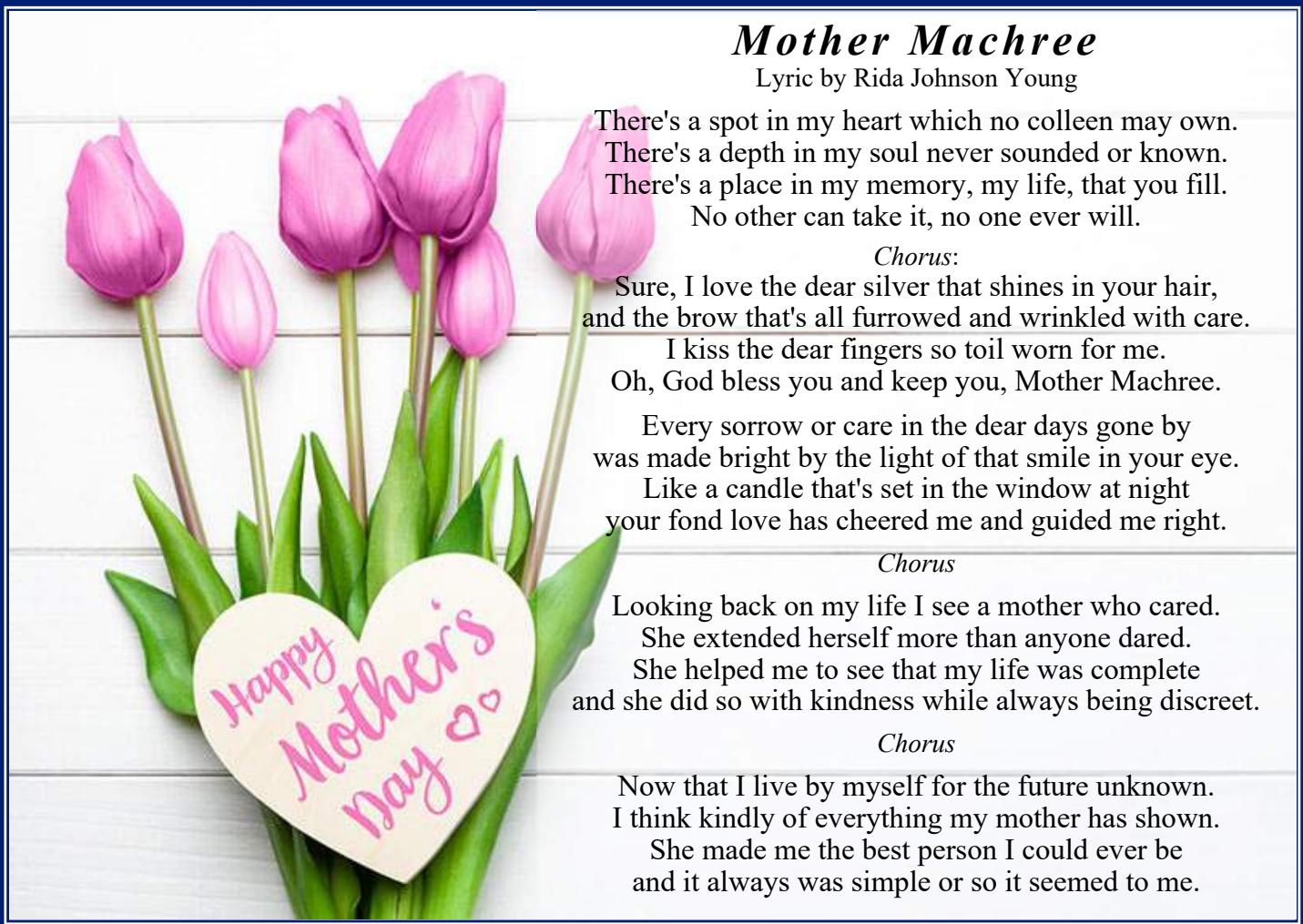
Every sorrow or care in the dear days gone by
