In 1597, a young man by the name Joseph Calasanz established a religious community to serve the Lord in the field of education. The first school to be opened was in Rome in the same year to serve the needs of the children of the area, particularly of the poor. The years go by and now that community, the Piarist Fathers, serve primarily in education in over 30 countries world-wide with 1300 members. Joseph Calasanz was canonized a saint in 1767.
