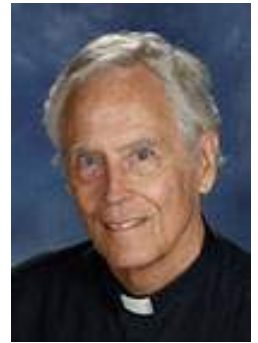
“Grateful Thanks”
